

The following terms and conditions govern all use of the Amplifr website ("the Website"). The Website is offered subject to your acceptance without modification of all of the terms and conditions contained herein and all other operating rules, policies (including, without limitation, Amplifr's Privacy Policies) and procedures that may be published from time to time on this Site by Amplifr (collectively, the "Agreement").

Please read this Agreement carefully before accessing or using the Website. By accessing or using any part of the web site, you agree to become bound by the terms and conditions of this agreement. If you do not agree to all the terms and conditions of this agreement, then you may not access the Website or use any services. If these terms and conditions are considered an offer by Amplifr, acceptance is expressly limited to these terms. The Website is available only to individuals who are at least 13 years old.

1. Access to your Amplifr Account

Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the Service is solely for User's personal use. As used herein, "User" includes Amplifr's paying customers ("Customers"). This Agreement sets forth certain terms and conditions that apply to Customers, but not other Users. In the event any Customer-specific terms or conditions conflict with any of the terms or conditions that apply to Users generally, the Customer-specific terms/conditions shall control.

Amplifr may change, suspend or discontinue the Services at any time, including the availability of any feature, database, or content. Amplifr may also impose limits on certain features and services or restrict User's access to parts or all of the Services without notice or liability.

User certifies to Amplifr that if User is an individual (i.e., not a corporation) User is at least 13 years of age. User also certifies that it is legally permitted to use the Service, and takes full responsibility for the selection and use of the the Service. This Agreement is void where prohibited by law, and the right to access the Service is revoked in such jurisdictions.

User shall be responsible for obtaining and maintaining any equipment or ancillary services needed to connect to, access the Service, including, without limitation, modems, hardware, software, and long distance or local telephone service. User shall be responsible for ensuring that such equipment or ancillary services are compatible with the Service.

2. Restrictions

User shall not, nor permit anyone else to, directly or indirectly:

Amplifr reserves the right to bar any such activity.

User shall not take any action that imposes an unreasonable or disproportionately large load on the infrastructure of the Service or Amplifr's systems or networks, or any systems or networks connected to the Service or to Amplifr.

User shall not use any device, software or routine to interfere or attempt to interfere with the proper working of the Service or any transaction being conducted on the Service, or with any other person's use of the Service.

User shall not use the Service or any Content for any purpose that is unlawful or prohibited by this Agreement.

3. Fees and Payment

Paid services are available on the Website. By selecting a paid service you agree to pay Amplifr the monthly or annual subscription fees indicated for that service. Payments will be charged on

4. Registration; Security

5. Termination

Amplifr may terminate your access to all or any part of the Website at any time, with or without cause, with or without notice, effective immediately. If you wish to terminate this Agreement or your Amplifr account (if you have one), you may simply discontinue using the Website. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if you have a paid account, such account can only be terminated by Amplifr if you materially breach this Agreement and fail to cure such breach within thirty (30) days from Amplifr's notice to you thereof; provided that, Amplifr can terminate the Website immediately as part of a general shut down of our service. All provisions of this Agreement which by their nature should survive termination shall survive termination, including, without limitation, ownership provisions, warranty disclaimers, indemnity and limitations of liability.

If User is a Customer, Amplifr makes the following warranty to Customer: Amplifr shall use commercially reasonable efforts consistent with prevailing industry standards to provide the services in a professional and workmanlike manner that is free of defects. Customer's sole remedy, and Amplifr's exclusive liability, for defects in the Service shall be for Amplifr to use commercially reasonable efforts to promptly correct such defects.

Customer represents and warrants that: (i) with respect to all information it provides to Amplifr (such as, Recipient Information), Customer has the full right and authority to make such provision and to allow Amplifr to use such information to provide the Service (including, without limitation, for Amplifr to provide such information to its data providers), (ii) none of the content (e.g. emails) transmitted, uploaded or otherwise distributed by it (or its partners or any third party) through use of the Service will infringe or otherwise conflict with the rights of any third party.

9. Warranty Disclaimer

The Website is provided "as is".
